



CBWC Charity Support Policy

This document outlines the Cairns Business Women's Club's (CBWC) policy in relation to support of charities and not-for-profit organisations.

This policy applies to all requests for the CBWC's support of any charity organisation or group, not-for-profit organisation or other entity.

Key Information

The CBWC is a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to facilitating a business community that is inspirational, collaborative and sustainable - generating success. Although the CBWC aims to cooperate with other bodies and associations, it is not an aim of the CBWC to raise monies for other not-for-profit organisations or charities.

Each year the CBWC does support charities as determined by the CBWC Board:

- 1) In partnership with the Australian Institute of Management by co-hosting the Great Debate. This event raises money for a predetermined local charity; and
- 2) At the CBWC Christmas Function, where the CBWC raises monies for a charity determined by the CBWC Board.

eNotice Board Access

Not-for-profit organisations can request (via the CBWC website) to access the eNotice Board for a nominal fee. This fee is incurred to support the administration of such a posting.

This eNotice Board is designed for business-to-business advertising and not as a community notice board. Whilst not-for-profit events can be posted, the CBWC reserves the right to remove any notices from the eNotice Board if messages are deemed inappropriate by the CBWC Board. A full refund will be made for any messages removed by the CBWC Board.

Requests for Support

- All requests (including, but not limited to: free advertising, donations, recognition of any kind or FOC attendance to any event) must be made in writing to the CBWC Board.
- Requests will be reviewed by the CBWC and the applicant will be notified in writing of the Board's decision.
